

SUMMER SCHOOL ON PRECARIOUS HOUSING WITH A FOCUS ON ROMA SETTLEMENTS

The lack of decent, affordable housing and the occurrence of informal, illegal, or unsafe housing across all EU Member States poses a threat to social inclusion in the EU, and hinders the mobility of EU citizens and the integration of third-country nationals. However, so far the issue has not been taken up systematically in curricula in higher education across Europe.

On this basis, we are developing learning materials on this topic within the PusH partnership. During our summer school, we combine these with hands-on activities to ensure an engaging learning atmosphere. We warmly invite students and lecturers to join us and learn more about one of the pressing issues of our time. While we hope to be able to welcome you in Bulgaria, we plan to offer alternative remote options, depending on the circumstances.

Contents:

- Reasons for challenges and possible solutions of precarious housing – incl. discussions with policy makers and social workers
- Field trips and meetings with people living in precarious housing with focus on segregated Roma settlements near Sofia
- Practical tasks, incl. international teamwork, development of materials and exchanges with European researchers
